

**2020-2021 CITRUS COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION  
OPEN YOUTH BEEF SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS**

**\$20.00 ENTRY FEE PER ANIMAL (CITRUS COUNTY)**

**\$30.00 ENTRY FEE PER ANIMAL (OUT OF COUNTY)**

**(ENTRY FEES NON-REFUNDABLE)**

1. Entries in the show will be accepted from all counties in Florida. Exhibitors must be, as of September 1, 2020, Ages 8 - 21 years old.
2. An entry fee of \$20.00 per animal for (In County) residents and a \$30.00 per animal for (Out of County) residents is due with registration no later than 5:00 PM on Thursday, March 4, 2021.  
Entries will be taken up to the day of Show with a \$20.00 per animal (In County) and \$30.00 per animal for (Out of County) with a required \$15.00 Late fee per animal. Cash only day of show for all fees.  
  
Persons wishing to enter showmanship class must designate at the time of registration and pay a non-refundable fee of \$10.00 (Participation is optional).
3. All entries must be positively, individually identified as follows: registered heifers, cows or bulls as per association requirements. Unregistered heifers, cows or bulls by brand, tattoo, Brucellosis Tag or USDA approved Ear Tag.
4. This show is open to any beef heifer, bull or cow except those containing more than fifty percent dairy breeding.
5. **All Beef Exhibitors participating in any event on the fairgrounds must provide a current Health Certificate for their animal according to the Florida Department of Agriculture guideline. Health Certificate must be presented prior to animal being removed from the trailer. The Health Certificate will be at the owners expense. The Livestock Committee will no longer offer this service.**
6. All animals must be polled or dehorned before entering the barn, although scurs are acceptable.
7. **All Livestock exhibitors will be admitted Free during their program through the Livestock Gate. ALL OTHERS MUST PAY GATE PRICE OR SHOW FAIR MEMBERSHIP CARD (DEADLINE TO PURCHASE A FAIR MEMBERSHIP IS FEBRUARY 26, 2021).**
8. All vehicles used to service animals (such as feed) must take place between the time the gates open and one hour before Fair opens to the public. ALL UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES MUST BE MOVED OUTSIDE THE FENCE ONE-HOUR BEFORE FAIR OPENS TO PUBLIC.
9. No exhibitors will be allowed in the barn after the Fair closes for the night or permitted to camp on the grounds.
10. A culling judge will be present to sift any undesirable animals.
11. All entries must be double tied by a proper neck strap or neck rope and a lead rope.
12. Nose rings or nose restraints with lead attached are permitted for Bulls only
13. All entries will be weighed and shown according to weight. All animals will be weighed in between 8:00 am and 10:00 am on **Sunday, March 28, 2021.**  
  
\* The animals will be divided into 6 classes according to their weight; All cows and calf by her side will show in class 7. The Calf, at cow's side, must be under 6 months of age to show in the cow class 7.  
  
\* The bulls will be divided into 4 classes according to their weight.
14. **CLASS AWARDS:**  
There will be 1 Grand Champion and 1 Reserve Grand Champion Female chosen from the 7 classes. There will be 1 Grand Champion and 1 Reserve Grand Champion Male chosen from the 4 classes.
15. **Thank you letters for Awards must be in the Fair Office before a check will be issued to the Exhibitor. Thank You letter deadline is on the Revised 10/2020 Important Dates and Educational Meeting Info schedule. Bring your letters to the Fair Office - Letters must be stamped, addressed and unsealed with your return address on the envelope. All money will be withheld until letters are written. Should deadline be missed there will be a \$25.00 forfeit fee subtracted from your premiums.(There is a sponsor address label on the bottom of the awards.)**

PAYOUT FOR SHOWMANSHIP WILL BE A PERCENTAGE OF ENTRY FEE FOR JR, INT AND SR ONLY.

17. All Livestock Committee's decisions are final.
18. The Citrus County Fair Livestock Board reserves the right to reject or accept conditionally any entry or application at any time or revoke premiums earned for just cause, or bar exhibitor from exhibiting. Failure to comply with any of the rules and regulations will subject the party to disqualification and removal from the Fairgrounds.
19. All Open Beef Exhibitors will remain on the grounds until excused by the Beef Superintendent.
20. All exhibitors are required to wear long pants at all times. No shorts will be permitted during this project while on the fairgrounds.
21. The above rules can only be changed between April 1 and the third Monday in July, unless a 2/3 majority vote of the Livestock Board and the approval of the Executive Committee of the Citrus County Fair Board with notification to each exhibitor.
