

## 2020-2021 Citrus County Fair Association Pee Wee & Youth Poultry Show Rules & Regulations

1. (A) All Pee Wee Exhibitors must be **under** 8 years of age as of September 1, 2020 to show in the Pee Wee Poultry program. Exhibitor must register their animal with the Citrus County Fair Association.  
All Youth Exhibitors must be 8 years of age or **older** as of September 1, 2020 to show in the Youth Poultry program. Exhibitor must register their animal with the Citrus County Fair Association.  
(B) **Pee Wee** Entry form and Entry fee of \$5.00 per bird (non-refundable) must be in the fair office on or before 5:00 pm Friday, January 22, 2021. You may enter a maximum of 2 birds.  
(C) **Youth** Entry form and Entry fee of \$5.00 per bird (non-refundable) must be in the fair office on or before 5:00 pm Friday, January 22, 2021. Maximum cost not to exceed \$15.00 per Exhibitor. You are limited to a total of 4 birds. Youth exhibitors must be a Citrus County 4-H or FFA member for the duration of their project. The 4-H Club or FFA Chapter must be recognized by the 4-H office or School to register to show.  
(D) The Livestock Committee will present at least **two** educational meetings during the project period (August through February). **REFER TO THE IMPORTANT DATES AND EDUCATIONAL MEETING SHEET.** The Exhibitor and a Parent or Legal Guardian **WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND TOGETHER**, at least **ONE** of these to **SHOW**. **Exhibitor and Parent or Legal Guardian, must STAY for the meeting AND sign in and sign out to receive credit for attending. If you and your parent or legal guardian are unable to attend one of these meetings, the intended exhibitor should not register an animal to show. Pee Wee Exhibitors are encouraged to attend the Youth Educational Meeting.**  
  
Only purebred birds will be accepted in the Pee Wee and Youth Show, with the exception of the Production class.  
  
There will be no advertising or “For Sale” signs for animal at the educational meeting or during the Fair.  
  
All animals must be at least **3 months of age** at registration.
2. **NO SICK OR DISEASED ANIMALS WILL BE ALLOWED.** They will be inspected.
3. This project begins on the registration deadline for Poultry. Preparing for the arrival of chicks is an important part of this project. The project will end on Poultry check in day. Youth Exhibitor is responsible for submitting a completed record book before Poultry can be checked in at the Poultry barn.
4. The Livestock Committee will present at least one educational meeting during the project period (August through February). The Exhibitor and a Parent or Guardian, 4-H Leader, FFA Teacher or responsible Adult, **WILL BE REQUIRED TO ATTEND TOGETHER**, at least **ONE** of these in order to **SHOW**. **Exhibitor and Parent or Guardian, 4-H Leader, FFA Teacher or responsible Adult must sign in and sign out to receive credit for attending.**
5. All poultry must be delivered to the Fairgrounds on **Sunday, March 28, 2021 between 3:00 P.M. - 5:00 P.M.** It's the Exhibitor's responsibility to check Fair website for updated information. Show schedule subject to change, you will be notified of any changes. All exhibitors must bring in a labeled waterproof container with enough food to feed their animal for the duration of the fair. **All Livestock exhibitors will be admitted Free during their program through the Livestock Gate. ALL OTHERS MUST PAY GATE PRICE OR SHOW FAIR MEMBERSHIP CARD (DEADLINE TO PURCHASE A FAIR MEMBERSHIP IS FEBRUARY 26, 2021).**
6. Poultry Superintendent may ask the Exhibitor to be present for showing during the showing of the poultry. This will be announced at the Exhibitor Meeting on the day of entry to the Fair. Check General Rules 6A and/or 6B for the appropriate dress code for your project.
7. Pee Wee exhibitors may enter a total of 2 birds and Youth exhibitors may enter a total of 4 birds. Limitation of entries may be enforced by the show superintendent due to limited space available.
8. Exhibitors cannot compete against themselves.

- 9. Poultry will be released on **Wednesday, March 24, 2021 between 10:00 P.M. and 11:00 P.M.** Animals will not be released before this time. We will not be responsible for any animals left after this time. Other arrangements must be made in advance and approved by the show superintendent. Release time may change - you will be notified of any changes.
- 10. Any exhibitor winning Awards, Skill-a-thon or Belt Buckle is required to write a "THANK YOU" Letter to the sponsor. Thank you letters can be given to show superintendent, prior to picking up your animals on **Wednesday, March 24, 2021.** Thank you letters for Awards, Skill-a-thon or Belt Buckle must be in the Fair Office before a check will be issued to the Exhibitor. Thank You letter deadline is on the Revised 10/2020 Important Dates and Educational Meeting Info schedule. **(No Letters will be taken at Barn Clean-up).** Bring your letters to the Fair Office - Letters must be stamped, addressed **and unsealed with your return address on the envelope.** All money will be withheld until letters are written. Should deadline be missed there will be a \$25.00 forfeit fee subtracted from your premiums.(There is a sponsor address label on the bottom of the awards and belt buckle.)
- 11. **PREMIUMS AND AWARDS** - Entries will be judging by the Modified Danish System.

**AWARDS:**

Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion and Class Winner - awards will not be given out if animal isn't awarded a blue ribbon. Record Books 4-H (JR, INT & SR) & FFA (JR & SR)

**YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP**

Youth Exhibitor wishing to compete in the optional showmanship must designate so at time of Registration and pay a Non-Refundable fee of \$5.00. Pee Wee program does not have a showmanship class available.

**PAYOUT FOR YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP IS A PERCENTAGE OF ENTRY FEES COLLECTED:**

1 <sup>ST</sup>	25% OF THE ENTRY FEES	4 <sup>TH</sup>	15% OF THE ENTRY FEES
2 <sup>ND</sup>	20% OF THE ENTRY FEES	5 <sup>TH</sup>	12 1/2% OF THE ENTRY FEES
3 <sup>RD</sup>	17 1/2% OF THE ENTRY FEES	6 <sup>TH</sup>	10% OF THE ENTRY FEES

RIBBONS WILL BE AWARDED 1<sup>ST</sup> THROUGH 6<sup>TH</sup>

- 12. Failure to comply with any of the above rules and regulations will subject the exhibitor to disqualification and removal from the project or Fairgrounds.
- 13. All exhibitors are encouraged to participate in the optional Poultry Skill-a-thon during Fair Week. The age of skill-a-thon and record books will be determined by the Exhibitor's age, prior to September 1, 2020.
- 14. **Mandatory to attend Barn Set-up or Barn Clean-Up - REFER TO THE IMPORTANT DATES AND EDUCATIONAL MEETING SHEET. Exhibitor must sign in and sign out to receive credit for attending.** Anyone unable to attend must contact the Livestock Committee Chairman, in writing, prior to Barn Set-up OR Barn Clean-up. Failure to attend and participate in Barn Set-up OR Barn Clean-up will result in a \$150.00 fine or forfeit their premium monies, to be put into the Dr. Dumas Scholarship fund. If you do not attend Barn Set-up OR Barn Clean-up you will not be allowed to show in the Youth Poultry Show the following year. **Pee Wee exhibitors are encouraged to attend but not MANDATORY.**
