- 1. Exhibitor must be a Citrus County 4-H or FFA member in good standing for the project's duration. The 4-H office or school must recognize the 4-H Club or FFA Chapter to register a show or sale animal. Exhibitors must be at least eight (8) years of age as of September 1 prior to the March Fair, to show and must register with the Citrus County Fair.
- 2. Entry form and fee must be in the fair office before the 5:00 pm deadline. (Refer to Important Dates on the Livestock Schedule.) Animals must be 3 months of age by the registration date. Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. Metered or postmarked entries will not be accepted after the deadline.
- **3.** Exhibitor may enter up to four (4) birds. Only purebred birds will be accepted, except for the Production Class. Participation in Youth Showmanship is optional. There may be a limitation of entries based on space needs.
 - 4. AWARDS & PREMIUMS; Ribbons will be awarded 1st 6th

Class winners will receive awards.

Class awards will be for classes with three (3) or more entries in a class. If there are single or double entries they will be combined to one class.

Youth Poultry Grand Champion \$25.00 must have won a blue ribbon

Reserve Grand Champion \$15.00

Showmanship Competition - non-refundable

The payout for showmanship for Jr., Int., and Sr. is a percentage of entry fees collected.

Ribbons awarded for 1st - 6th

1st - 25% 2nd - 20% 3rd - 17% 4th - 15% 5th^h - 13% 6th - 10%
