2026 SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Exhibitor must be a Citrus County 4-H or FFA member in good standing for the project's duration. The 4-H office or school must recognize the 4-H Club or FFA Chapter to register a show or sale animal. Exhibitors must be at least eight (8) years of age as of September 1 prior to the March Fair, to show and must register with the Citrus County Fair.

2. Entry form and fee must be in the fair office before the 5:00 pm deadline. (Refer to Important Dates on the Livestock Schedule.) Animals must be **3 months of age** by the registration date. Incomplete entry forms will not be accepted. Metered or postmarked entries will not be accepted after the deadline.

3. Exhibitor may enter up to four (4) birds. Only purebred birds will be accepted, except for the Production Class. Participation in Youth Showmanship is optional. There may be a limitation of entries based on space needs.

4. AWARDS & PREMIUMS; Ribbons will be awarded 1st - 6th

Class winners will receive awards.

1st \$10.00 2nd \$5.00 3rd \$4.00 4th \$3.00 5th \$2.00 6th \$1.00

Class awards will be for classes with three (3) or more entries in a class. If there are single or double entries they will be combined to one class.

Youth Poultry Grand Champion \$25.00 **must have won a blue ribbon**

Reserve Grand Champion \$15.00

Showmanship Competition - non-refundable

The payout for showmanship for Jr., Int., and Sr. is a percentage of entry fees collected.

Ribbons awarded for 1st - 6th

1st - 25% **2nd** - 20% **3rd** - 17% **4th** - 15% **5th** - 13% **6th** - 10%
