In memory of Marty Dolley, an anonymous donor has established a graduating senior scholarship fund. This scholarship is to support 4-H and FFA students interested in continuing their education at a 2 or 4 year college or trade school. Two (2) \$500.00 scholarships will be awarded to graduating high school seniors who are **exhibiting market steers** at the 2026 Citrus County Fair.

The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage young people to pursue their future career goals. Applicants must be participants in the 2026 Citrus County Fair to qualify. **The application must be in to the Fair Office no later than 5:00 pm on Friday, February 27, 2026. No postmarked or metered mail after the deadline will be accepted. Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

1. Applicants must be Citrus County 4-H Members or FFA Members in good standing and of graduating status.
2. **The applicant must be a Steer Exhibitor at the 2026 Citrus County Fair.**
3. The Scholarship must be used at an approved institution of higher education, within 2 years of graduation from high school.
4. The award will be presented at an official activity of the Citrus County Fair.
5. The selection committee will require a personal interview with the applicant.
6. The applicant must complete an essay. The essay must accompany the application. In life Marty shared his ideals with many people: to work hard, to keep your word, to tell the truth, to love one another, and to have fun in all that you do. **In your own words, and using specific examples, explain how your life relates to these ideals, that meant so much to him.**
